Now they were looking at me and thinking GiGi is not just the girl in the corner. So when I hid it, things started changing for me. People looked at me differently after that. Also when I was at Chibudi, I was always worried that people would vote me off, and when the merge happened I was saved. I saw that there were loads of strong guys who the girls would go after first. I was saved by that merge.

What memories will you take away from this?

I worked with such a wonderful bunch of people. Seeing Okkert in action was amazing. He's such an athlete. Also I have never been so cold and hungry as I was out there and I will remember that, too. For us that came to an end, but there are a lot of people who live like that in South Africa and I now understand why people steal in order to eat.

Did you make any friends for life on the show?

I made friends, I'm not sure whether we will be long time friends who visit each other all the time. I am sure they'll pop into the club from time to time, and I will happily feed them all, eternally. We may work together, too, but we haven't gone into any details yet.

Tell us about your charity. Why did you choose them?

Hospice Houghton has been the charity of the club since we started five years ago. My co-partner's wife died of cancer, and I went through the whole thing with their family and saw the work these people at the Hospice do, free of charge.

The way they deal with the situation, so calm, so compassionate. It's such a good cause.

What are you going to do with your share of the winnings?

I am renovating the club and building a new dressing room for the girls. The rest is just going to be for sensible things like my bond.
